

BIO Wall Paint
- Interior White and Mixed Colours

BIO Wall Paint comes as a white base with the pigments supplied separately. This gives you the design freedom to fine tune your colours on the job that you wish. The colour chart shows a few examples of what can be achieved. BIO Wall Paint has excellent hiding power and can be applied over plaster, wall-paper, gyprock and conventional paint in the usual way. Gloss or semi-gloss paint has to be sanded first.

- Proper Surface Preparation is the key to a quality paint finish:
- Examine the plaster for cracks or marks
  - Fill cracks and sand lightly when dry
  - Clean the surface to remove dirt, oil, grease, rust and flaking paint

Test adhesion of previous coats: Cut small crosses through the paint, place sticky tape over the cuts and pull one end of the tape to rip off. If paint pulls away, surface is unsold.

Highly absorbent surfaces like Besser blocks, crumbly surfaces, mudbrick etc. require a coat of BIO WALL PRIMER.

For the best finish we recommend to use a roller sleeve 10-12mm pile. Transfer paint into tray or tub so that you can keep the lid on the original paint drum to prevent drying and crusting of paint on lid and sides, which may fall into the paint producing lumps. If you have any paint left over, transfer it into a small container to leave as little air as possible. This will prevent the paint from drying out and it can be used later for repaint or touch-up.



BIO Enamel Lacquer
- White and Undercoat

Bio Enamel Paint is a thick, dirt-repellent and water-repellent, gloss or satin painted finish, containing no toxic solvents, resins or heavy metals. Suitable for all wood types, steel, aluminium and copper. Especially useful for use on toys, panelling, skirtings and architraves, garage doors and window frames.

BIO Enamel Lacquer Gloss or Satin is suitable for interior use only. BIO Enamel Lacquer Exterior Satin is used for exterior surfaces.

Colours: BIO Enamel Lacquer and Undercoat are supplied in base white. Standard full colours are: Green, Yellow, Red, Ochre, Blue, Brown, Black. All colours can be used as tints and are intermixable.

BIO All Purpose Varnish
- Interior

A transparent varnish in gloss or satin providing a colourless, hard but flexible dirt-repellent and water-repellent finish. Sweat and saliva proof. For use on all interior timber surfaces, such as windows, banisters, furniture, toys, ceilings and panelling. Not recommended for constantly humid environments such as bathrooms and laundries. Note: for timber flooring, benchtops and kitchen areas, use BIO Floor Varnish, gloss or satin.

BIO Wood Varnish
- Coloured interior, exterior or clear

A hard, elastic, transparent or semi-transparent varnish for use on timber surfaces. It is resistant to dirt and moisture and is not affected by sweat or saliva. We add ingredients which makes it stronger against U-V radiation.

Colours: Standard colours are Redwood, Mahogany, Teak, Walnut, Pine, Ebony black, Grey, White, Oak, Green and Red. Slight variations between lots are possible. Special colours are available upon request. All colours are intermixable.

Japanese Seedlac

A high quality timber polish, similar to shellac but with greater resistance to wear and temperature. A superb French polish, preferred by professionals for superior clarity and durability. For interior use on fine furniture, musical instruments, cabinets etc.


MISSION STATEMENT
